Members, It is a privilege to serve as YOUR Chief Range Safety Officer.

We continue to increase the number of Range Safety Officers we have to serve you and keep everyone safe. Please be patient with the RSOs because, as you know, it can be a very challenging job when 30-50% of our shooters on a given day can be non-members, and some have never shot a gun. Many of our RSOs are long-time members like yourselves and have many long-standing friendships with all of you. They are ALL VOLUNTEERS and do this RSO job to keep the range safe and NOT for the small stipend the club pays at the end of the year which barely covers mileage and lunch. Please forgive us if we don't look you right in the eye while talking with you during range operations. The RSOs are keeping their eyes moving and heads on a swivel to watch out for any unsafe situation.

Just a reminder that YOU can help us keep the range safe for all shooters. If you ever see something that appears unsafe, please notify an RSO so they can address it. Being long-time members, you can be of great assistance as a second pair of eyes. If you ever see a situation that may be life-threatening, feel free to yell for a cease-fire. We can always sort it out and make sure everyone remains safe.

Finally, please feel free to reach out to me if you have any safety concerns about the range, and THANK YOU for coming to the range to exercise your 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment rights.
