Projects, Projects, and More Projects...

So, you may ask, what are some of the major accomplishments of the current Dade City Gun Club Administration that has just completed its first year since the April 2022 election? Well, here are a few of the completed projects and a few of those approved and currently on the road to completion as well as other endeavors being considered.

One of the first projects completed was the clearing of brush and trees on the side berms of all three ranges. This was badly needed to make it easier and safer for shooters and RSO's to have better site lines for all our ranges. While doing that, we determined our property lines and placed many No Trespassing signs and Active Live Fire signs on all sides of the club.

Next, we completed the removal of our old rotted wooden stairs to the DCGC Public Range and replaced them with wider concrete stairs that have a non-slip surface for safety and new aluminum handrails that patrons can safely use as they enter and exit the public range.



One of the ongoing projects has been the sprucing up of our club house with new paint, new crown molding that replaced the 2X4 molding that was there, and the remodeling of our kitchen with new cabinets, shelving, and counter tops.

Some of this work has been done in-house thus keeping costs down. Recently we ordered new ceiling fans to replace the fifty-year-old fans that were there. Additionally, we fixed the A/C issues for the office area and had a programmable thermostat installed that will save on electrical costs.

You may have noticed that the main club house is a place where having a conversation has become easier since we installed sound absorbing panels. For years hearing each other has been difficult. This has now been addressed with those panels.

In order to protect and maintain the integrity of our range, we will soon have steel baffles installed on both ranges that will only make shooting safer. In addition, we have decided to replace the wooden baffles on the 50 year range ourselves, since the bids have come in extremely high. **We hope to announce a "raise the baffle" day in order to get enough volunteer workers so that we can complete this project in a day or two.**

A more recent project that many of you have noticed is the new safety briefing on the public range and the new wooden fence at the top of our new stairs. Each of these projects were originated and completed in house.

Finally, we have estimates for a new fence at the main entrance of our club. We will likely move this project into another budget cycle along with other projects, one of which addresses the berms and how best to deal with them.

Hope you enjoy knowing about some of the projects we have been doing to make our club safer and more enjoyable for all of you, our dedicated members, and Range Safety Officers. **And a BIG Thank You to all of the volunteers who have worked so hard to make these projects a success**. We will continue to keep you updated as we grow into the future.
