

# SPRING NEWS FROM THE DADE CITY GUN CLUB






The Membership Appreciation Cookout was a great success! We had approximately 92 members come out and enjoy the great food and company. We look forward to next year being even bigger and better!

#### Robert (Rob) Stansberry


